1. Background

The competition was firstly organised in 2007. The award was named "YMC Student Scholarship" and participants were required to submit a research paper on Transport and/or Logistics. To distinguish it from the CILTHK Scholarship and other academic awards, it was renamed as Case Competition in 2015.

The award shall be awarded to full-time undergraduate students (bachelor or sub-degree) studying in Hong Kong tertiary education institution. The focus of their studies must be transport and/or logistics or related discipline. Submissions can be on individual basis or a group of a maximum of 4 members.

2. Theme and Assessment Criteria

The theme for 2016's competition was set as "Innovative Ideas for Logistics and Transport Industry in Hong Kong". Participants were free to set their research projects.
