# MOU between UN Office for South-South Cooperation and HSMC For Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) & Training Programmes

On 15 January 2016, the UN Office for South-South Cooperation (UNOSSC) and the Centre for Corporate Sustainability and Innovations (CCSI) in Hang Seng Management College, Hong Kong, signed an agreement to mutually pursue the goals of engaging teaching institutions and the private sector on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and providing training programmes that will focus on effective entrepreneurship education, including social entrepreneurship. The two organisations first discussed the mutual interest in September 2015.

"This collaboration reflects our strategy to work with a centre of excellence to help us address development issues. "Capacity development has to be on an on-going basis via a strong network of partners with a shared vision and outcomes," says Dr Shirley Yeung, the Director of the Centre for Corporate Sustainability and Innovations.
