HSUHK to hold Information Day on 15 November

The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong (HSUHK) will host its Information Day on 15 November 2025 (Saturday), welcoming prospective students, parents, teachers and the public. The event will feature over 30 themed trial lessons and interactive workshops, alongside the latest AI applications display, programme exhibitions, student life tours, admission talks, and campus tours. These activities will provide insights into HSUHK's latest academic programmes, on-campus life, admission requirements, and scoring methods.

On-site applications and assessments will be available during the event. Applicants who complete the application process (submitting online application and application fee payment) on the day and meet eligibility criteria, may receive first-round conditional offers in December 2025. To accommodate students taking the HKDSE, sub-degrees, or Mainland Gaokao, a series of admission talks and Q&A sessions will be conducted in Cantonese and Putonghua, providing the most up-to-date admission information for 2026 entry.

The event will feature a keynote address at 2 pm titled "Selection Strategies for Undergraduate Programmes" by Mr Raymond Ip, Chairperson of the Hong Kong Association of Careers Masters and Guidance Masters, who will share 2025 admission data and programme selection strategies. Additionally, Professor Joshua Mok, Provost and Vice-President (Academic and Research) of HSUHK and Mr Ng Po-shing, Student Guidance Consultant at Hok Yau Club will lead an interactive seminar titled "Future vs Prestige: How to choose?" at 10 am. The seminar will cover student admission trends, common mistakes in choosing educational pathways and strategies to avoid them, as well as the role of parents in guiding their children's decisions, among other topics.

Other programme talks and workshops include: "Junji Ito's horror manga — The geographical factors presented by ethnology"; "Collage canvas: Unleashing creativity through art exploration as studio class methodology!"; "How marketing leads the future: Empowering people and brands"; and "Discover AI & computing @ HSUHK Computer Science", and more.

The University's MSc in Global Supply Chain Management programme was ranked 84th globally in the QS International Trade Rankings 2025 announced by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS). The programme was also ranked 7th in the Greater China region and 4th in Hong Kong. The School of Business



obtained AACSB International accreditation, a distinction achieved by only 6% of the world's leading business schools.
