HSUHK confers Honorary University Fellowships on three distinguished individuals today

The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong (HSUHK) held its Honorary University Fellowship Conferment Ceremony 2026 on campus today (25 March), bestowing honorary university fellowships on three outstanding individuals in recognition of their remarkable achievements in their professional fields, as well as their contributions to society and the University. The three recipients are: renowned business leader Ms Stella Fung Siu-wan, prominent industrialist Mr Alan Li Pui-leung, and eminent entrepreneur Mr Lim Soon-tiong. The Ceremony was officiated by Ms Luanne Lim, Chairman of the Board of Governors of HSUHK, and Dr the Hon Moses Cheng Mo-chi, Chairman of the HSUHK Council.
